



### The Lift (Reprise)

1. This island is the centerpiece of the project. The tower itself measures 8x16x14 feet (this does not include the elements attached to the south side). The lower 3 feet are concrete formation walls, with the higher elements wooden slats. It is a hollow structure and shell.

2. This is the platform attached to the south, a mixture of a wooden base and concrete elements. It is similar to small platforms for rallies or decks attached to homes (see research images).

3. These are concrete stumps 2 feet high. They are set in the ground and raise through the wooden platform. There are two of these (they are similar in form to the signpost stumps: see #5).

4. This is another mixture of concrete and wood, a formless structure that looks abandoned and incomplete.

5. Signpost. This is the base for a large signpost that was never erected. The concrete form remains and is a counterpoint to the island centerpiece.
